

Timeline for Robert Holt

(Updated February 2020)

1620

North Carolina/Virginia

First Holt in America, RANDOLPH HOLT, on The George in 1620, Was married in Hog Island NC(VA) in 1624. Listed as age 18 in 1620 with note "The rest of his servant's, Provisions, Ammunition &ct. at James City." (Musters of the Inhabitants of Virginia)

1605

Rochdale, Lancashire, Eng.

A ROBERT HOLTE, son of John Holt, born

1625, Dec.19

Manchester, Lancashire, Eng

A ROBERT HOULTE married a DOROTHIE HEAWOOD

1646

Maryland

ROBERT HOLT immigrated with wife and 4 children. (Dau. Eliz. died in England in 1633)

1646, March

Maryland

Land warrant for 400 acres for Robert (Patents ABH 32)

1646

Maryland

One thousand & thirty pounds of tobacco and corn sold to Robert by Francis Posey.

1647

Maryland

Posey owes Holt.

1647

Maryland

Robert files complaint about above transaction being wrongfully attached by C. Phenick

1648, Oct. 23

Maryland

Deposition of ROBERT HOLT, **aged 28**, concerning a pestle stolen by E. Commins.

1649

Maryland

EDWARD HUDSON, **age 25**. (J. Ifland information)

1649, July 20

Maryland

ROBERT HOLT promises to pay 2300 pounds of tobacco to P. Simpson.

1650, January 20

A Robert Holt in James city 1500 acres

1650

Maryland

EDWARD HUDSON defaulted on a bond and court allowed Robert Holt to "attach his estate" for the cost.

1651, Nov. 6
Maryland
Domestic problems. Dorothy Heywood and Edward Hudson guilty of adultery.

1653
Maryland
A Robt. Holt, planter. sells 5500 wt. Tobacco

1654, February
Will of Ann Brooks. Witnessed by R. Holt and Wilkinson, clerk

1654, Dec. 4
St. Georges, Maryland
Divorce granted, but clerk later denied it.

1657, Jan. 28
Maryland
Robert married CHRISTIAN BONNEFIELD

1658, Oct. 6
Maryland
Jury hears charges of bigamy against Robert. Dorothy had at least "2 bastards" by Edward Hudson.

1661, July
Maryland
ROBERT HOLT dies in St. Mary's Co. MD

1662, Nov. 28
Maryland
CHRISTIAN BONNEFIELD HOLT wife of deceased ROBERT, petitions court to provide or protect her possessions because Robert Holt's son DAVID HOLT threatens to turn her out into the woods.

1665, July
Maryland
Dorothy Holt (Robert's daughter) Indentured 5 years to Henry Aubry.

1672
Edward Hudson dies in Virginia. Dorothy listed as wife. (See info below on Edward Hudson)

Edward Hudson

1649	Record that Edward was 25 years old.
1650	Edward defaulted on a bond to Robert Holt
1651, November 6	Edward Hudson and Dorothy Heywood accused of adultery
1657, Dec. 10	Received title to property in Rappahannock Co., VA
1662, Nov. 1	Sold 300 acres (Old Rappahannock Co., VA) to John Hull
1664	Edward bought one hundred acres from RICHARD HOLT in Rappahannock Co. (This could have been Richard Holt, son of Richard)
1672, March 13	Edward Hudson Will made, mentions son John Barton, wife DOROTHY HUTSON, and ELIZABETH (relationship not mentioned). Old Rappahannock Co., VA

ROBERT HOLT (VARIOUS)

Robert Holt, husband of Dorothy Heywood and Christian Bonnifield, 1605-1661
All legal proceedings were in Maryland, ranging from 1646 to his death in 1661

Robert Holt, shown as age 28 in 1648, concerning a “pestle stolen by E. Commins” (I don’t have a son of Robert Holt named “Robert”)

Robert Holt Inventory of estate of deceased ROBT. HOLT, April 1698 (Richard Holt owed estate of Robert Holt 85 pds. Of tobacco.) This is probably Robert, son of Richard Holt (son of older Robert) Richard Holt would have been his brother.
